### **GOVERNMENT DISBURSES KSH. 4.6 BILLION FOR JUNE AND JULY 2025 INUA JAMII PROGRAMME**

---

The Ministry of Labour and Social Protection, through the State Department for Social Protection and Senior Citizen Affairs, has released **Ksh. Four Billion, Six Hundred and Seven Million, Six Hundred and Sixty-Eight Thousand (4,607,668,000)** for payment to **1,151,917 Older Persons and Persons Living With Severe Disabilities** enrolled in the Inua Jamii Program.

The disbursement covers stipends for both the June and July 2025 payment cycles. Each beneficiary will receive **Ksh. 4,000**, representing **Ksh. 2,000** per month for the two months. Payments commenced today.

The June cycle payment had been delayed due to a data cleanup exercise. The State Department apologizes to beneficiaries for any inconvenience caused by the delay.

The Inua Jamii Cash Transfer Programme aims to alleviate poverty and promote the well-being of society's most vulnerable members, including older persons aged 70 and above, orphans and vulnerable children, and persons with severe disability.

In line with the government's commitment to ensuring universal health coverage, the Ministry encourages all Inua Jamii beneficiaries to register with the Social Health Authority (SHA) to access affordable and quality healthcare.
